### **SKATE-ATHON UPDATE - February 21**

Bonnie Crater noticed the date we had picked out (1/31/93) coincided with the Super Bowl. So, the skateathon is now on for February 21. The game plan remains the same: participants skate as many laps as they can in the half-hour allotted. Sponsors can pay a flat rate, or on a per-lap basis. (We are holding this before the distance race Ross Zucco in L.A.)

Mary is going to various businesses rounding up prizes for participants. There will be a drawing for some of these awards immediately following the event, and then again two weeks later for the skaters who have turned in their pledges. It is a good idea to collect

<u>pledge money before</u> the event to be sure of being included in the second drawing.

## NCSA BOARD OF CONTROL MEETING

12/19/92--- Minutes in a Minute Bonnie, Chris, Jim, Paul, Greg, Mary

Main topics discussed were upcoming races divisions and awards, and GGSS and NCSA fundraising.

Jim set up the Tuesday ice sessions with the Ice Capades management. He was able to secure the ice at a bargain rate by putting up the money himself, with the understanding that GGSS will pay him back as the money is collected. Paul and Jim are in charge of getting the skaters committed to paying for a month at a time.

Money raised through the NCSA skateathon will help pay for the GGSS Tuesday sessions in the form of a \$4-per-skater persession subsidy, paid by the Association to the Club. If 15 skaters sign up, at \$7.50 per skater per session, the subsidy would allow GGSS to break even on the ice cost.

# NCSA TREASURER'S REPORT -- 1/30/93

The NCSA currently shows an account balance of \$588.10. This reflects income in amounts of \$1,071.00, for membership fees, \$220 in donations, and \$300 for receipts for the recent Northern California championship race.

Major expenses so far have been \$550 to the ASU for membership dues, \$140 for NCSA Championship race trophies, and \$292.50 for race ice costs. There were also some smaller expenditures, including copying costs and postage.

According to the NCSA bylaws, funds are reserved for one championship race per year, and promotion of NCSA active member clubs. Is is anticipated that all NCSA funds will be made available to member clubs, of which there is only one, GGSS, over the course of the fiscal year.

Given that most of the NCSA money comes in at the beginning of the fiscal year, in the form of membership dues, we will likely see a slow depletion of funds as NCSA continues to contribute to GGSS activities.

#### GRANT MONEY AND ASU MEMBERS

USISA (Speedskating's representative to the Olympic Committee) grants funds to the ASU for novice development. It is distributed to associations based on the number of 1st and 2nd-year skaters registered with the association.

NCSA will receive \$5.00 for each new skater and \$10.00 for each second-year skater registered. The membership year runs from Sept. 1 to Aug. 31. So, anyone with even a vague notion of attending a camp this summer, or going to a race in L.A. should be registered.
