OLYMPIC SPEEDSKATING IN SAN JOSE

The National Short-Track Ice Speedskating Championships will be held in San Jose March 19-21 at the San Jose Ice Centre.

Men and women speed skaters from all across the United States compete for the National titles in age-divisions for youth through veterans.

In short track speed skating groups of four or five skaters race on a 111 meter oval track on a hockey rink. Skaters are disqualified for deliberate bumping or blocking.

Close contact at high speeds with drafting, passing and breaking away, make this an exciting sport to watch.

The fastest skaters reach speeds of over 25 miles per hour, circling the track in under 10 seconds. The first blade across the line wins!

Skaters wear protective gear and there are pads along the walls, to protect skaters in case of crashes.

Limited supply of tickets available. \$5 per day or \$10 for three days. The rink is at 1500 10^{th} St., the corner of 10^{th} and Alma St., near Spartan Stadium and Kelley Park.

Racing: Friday noon to 5:00. Saturday 9 to 5:30. Sunday 9:00 to 4:00. Parking is free at the rink.

A current membership card will be required at all races.

The Racing Blade

All ASU members receive the ASU publication, *The Racing Blade*. This magazine is put out by skaters, for skaters. This is where you read about upcoming ASU programs and sanctioned races, and what is happening in other clubs around the country.

Training Camps

Any ASU member can attend one of many summer training camps as a means to improve technique, strength and stamina. Camps held at Olympic training centers offer one week room and board, ice time and coaching for a nominal fee.

Insurance

The ASU provides liability insurance for associations, clubs, officers, officials, and coaches. This allows its members to operate skating programs around the country.

A Vote for Speedskating

As a member of the NCSA and the ASU, you have a vote on NCSA elections and other matters put to the membership.

ASU Convention




